Dear Parent/Guardian

It is not long to go until our Residential Visit to White Hall now, and I would like to inform you about some further information regarding the visit.

YEAR 6 RESIDENTIAL VISIT

Children need to arrive at school at the usual time on Wednesday 15th June, but do not need to wear school uniform. They will need to bring a packed lunch in their small rucksack for them to eat on the way to the White Hall as we will walk part of the way through the Goyt Valley with our small rucksacks, whilst the Coach delivers our main bags to the centre. Pupils should also put a waterproof top in their small rucksack (or be wearing it) and wear sensible shoes or boots appropriate for walking on rough and muddy ground. Everything else should be packed into a large bag or suitcase. Specialist waterproofs, wellies and equipment for activities will be provided by White Hall Staff.

All medication (including inhalers) need to be placed in a plastic bag and given to a member of staff taking the visit, not just packed in children's bags. Furthermore, electrical items (such as mp3 players, phones or cameras) are not allowed. Your child can bring a torch if they would like to.

Sweets and chocolate are also not allowed to be taken by the children. However, pupils can bring £5 with them (in loose change) to use in order to purchase items from the White Hall Tuck Shop.
