



Kit List – Year 5 + 6 White Hall Residential 2026

Wednesday 17th June 2026: Pupils will need a small day ruck sack containing: sunhat, sun cream and insect repellent if necessary, water bottle and packed lunch for Nature Walk to White Hall Centre (no glass or fizzy drinks please.)

Following in one additional suitcase or large rucksack:

- At least 3 sets of outdoor clothing. Outdoor clothes may receive heavy wear so bring old but sturdy clothing (trousers, shirts/t-shirts, jumpers/sweatshirts) **NB: Jeans are unsuitable for outdoor activities**
- 2 or 3 sets of indoor clothing e.g. jogging bottoms, that can be worn for recreational time
- Indoor Shoes and Slippers for use inside the Centre at night.
- Training shoes for activities
- Walking boots if you have them.
- Old training shoes (for water-based activities)
- Nightwear and underwear
- Toiletries, soap, towel, toothbrush etc.
- Torch
- Scarf, hat and gloves in cold weather
- Spending money for the Tuck Shop – less than £5 but in change please.

No electronic devices or mobile phones. No sweets or chocolate.

White Hall Centre provided waterproofs and other equipment requirement depending on the different activities that pupils will be doing. Pupils can bring their own waterproofs if they wish to but this is not necessary.

Please ensure clothing is clearly labelled.
