The school choir now have so many members that there are two parts, Choir A and B, who sing on alternate weeks! Thank you to Mr Sheppeck for conducting them.

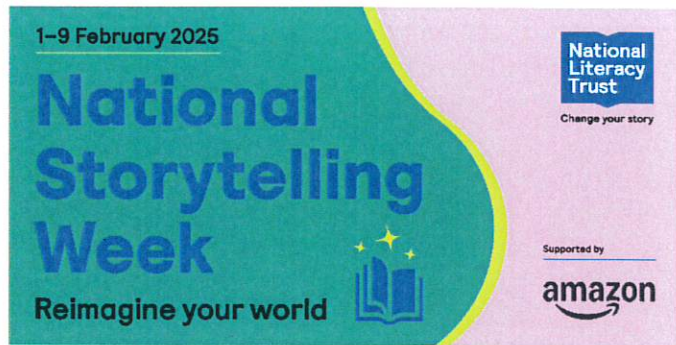
The Netball Tournament

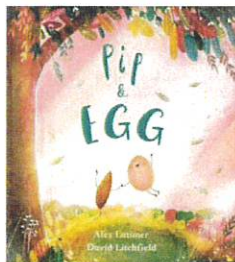
Mental Health Week



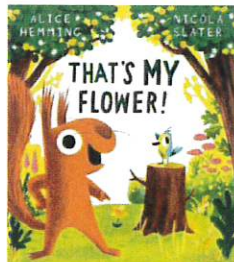

This activity helped all to focus on their hopes, dreams, and what they want to achieve.

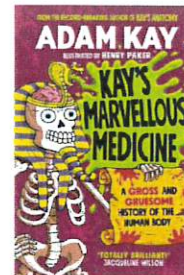
